1. Content & Required Sections	8 pts: Includes all required sections with complete and accurate information.	6 pts: Includes most required sections with generally accurate information.	4 pts: Several sections or important details are missing.	2 pts: Many sections are missing or incomplete.
2. Understanding of the Novel	8 pts: Shows excellent understanding of the story, characters, events and themes. Ideas are clearly explained in their own words.	6 pts: Shows good understanding of the novel and its main ideas.	4 pts: Shows partial understanding; some ideas are unclear or inaccurate.	2 pts: Shows limited understanding of the novel.
3. English: Vocabulary & Grammar	6 pts: Uses appropriate vocabulary and mostly accurate grammar. Errors do not affect communication.	5 pts: Uses appropriate vocabulary with some grammar errors. Communication is clear.	3 pts: Limited vocabulary and several grammar errors sometimes affect communication.	2 pts: Very limited vocabulary and frequent errors make communication difficult.
4. Oral Presentation	6 pts: Speaks clearly and confidently. Explains the project without depending heavily on reading. Good pronunciation and fluency.	5 pts: Speaks clearly with some hesitation. Uses notes occasionally.	3 pts: Reads frequently and shows noticeable hesitation.	2 pts: Has significant difficulty presenting and communicating ideas.
5. Lapbook: Organization & Creativity	4 pts: Very well organized, creative, neat and visually attractive. Information is easy to find.	3 pts: Well organized and attractive.	2 pts: Some organization and creative elements, but presentation could be improved.	1 pt: Disorganized, incomplete or difficult to understand.
6. Teamwork & Participation	4 pts: All members participate actively, share responsibilities and collaborate respectfully.	3 pts: Most members participate and collaborate well.	2 pts: Participation is uneven among members.	1 pt: Little collaboration or participation is evident.
7. Preparation & Responsibility	4 pts: The group is completely prepared, brings all materials and meets the deadline.	3 pts: The group is prepared with only minor difficulties.	2 pts: The group shows limited preparation or is missing some materials.	1 pt: The group is poorly prepared or does not meet the requirements.
